

Now friends climb aboard the Deadwood Stage for a night of fun with Calamity Jane.



JIM WILLIAMS - PRODUCER

Jim has directed and produced musicals and plays for our society since it was founded over ten years ago. In addition he has worked with the ESB Musical and Dramatic Society doing both plays and variety and with Dun Laoghaire Pieros on their Christmas Pantos. Among the plays Jim has produced have been O'Casey's "Plough and the Stars", Keane's "Big Maggie", Brian Farrell's "Canaries", Agatha Christies "The Hollow", and Wilde's "The Importance of Being Earnest". His Musicals include "Pirates of Penzance", "Carousel", "Showboat" also "Fiddler on the Roof" for Kilmacud, Harolds Cross and Tallaght Musical Society. Jim has worked with various youth groups and School Productions and last year he produced our highly successful "My Fair Lady"

RAY RYAN - MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Ray Ryan has worked in many prominent Musical Socities in varying capacities, Chorus, Principal Roles, Chorus Master and M.D. and played parts such as Mr. Snow (Carousel) and Mr. Bumble (Oliver) among many others. In addition to his interest in Musical Socities he is founder of the Firhouse Singers and Voice Squad (a close harmony barbershop group) winners last year of the Barbershop Chorus Compition. He is also Cofounder and M.D. of Marian College / St. Marys School, Musical Society who have just successfully performed "South Pacific"

PADDI MULHOLLAND - CHOREOGRAPHER

Paddi trained in Classical Ballet, Modern Jazz and Tap. During her professional dancing career which spanned 13 years she appeared in all major Theatres in this country in T.V. and in Films. Since turning her talents to Chorography shows to her credit include, "The Pyjama Game", "Half a Sixpence", "My Faie Lady", "Oaklahoma", and "The King and I". Paddi also adjudicates amateur variety shows such as the "Cream of the Country". In her capicity as Hon. Secretary of the Irish region of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing, she is one of the organisers of an International Dance Congress, to be held in Dublin in October 1992.
