

#### JIM WILLIAMS - PRODUCER

Jim has directed and produced musicals and plays for our society since it was founded over ten years ago. In addition he has worked with the ESB Musical and Dramatic Society doing both plays and variety and with Dun Laoghaire Pieros on their Christmas Pantos. #### RAY RYAN - MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Ray Ryan has worked in many prominent Musical Societies in varying capacities, Chorus, Principal Roles, Chorus Master and M.D. and played parts such as Mr. Snow (Carousel) and Mr. Bumble (Oliver) among many others. In addition to his interest in Musical Societies he is founder of the Firhouse Singers and The Barber's Dozen (a close harmony barbershop group). He is also Co-founder and M.D. of Marian College / St. Mary's Musical Society who have just successfully performed "Fiddler on the Roof".

#### PADDI MULHOLLAND - CHOREOGRAPHER

Last October she was one of the organisers of the highly successful International Dance Congress, the first of its kind to be held in Ireland.

### SYNOPSIS The Scottish Highlands

We follow the villagers through a day that includes a wedding and learn that if one of the inhabitants should leave Brigadoon the spell will be broken for ever. There is a near disaster when a young embittered Scot tries to take his revenge. He dashes towards the forest but is killeed making his escape. Happiness is changed to mourning. Tommy has by now fallen deeply in love with Fiona but he is told he cannot stay. He goes back with Jeff to New York and quarrels with his fiancee. Suddenly ne must return to Scotland. There by the power of love he reawakens the slumbering Brigadoon just long enough for him to be reunited with Fiona.


