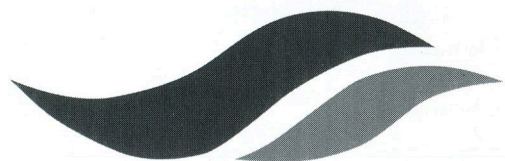

Kilmacud Musical & Dramatic Society first tread the boards in 1982 with the play *Big Maggie*, their first musical was staged in 1984, it was *Fiddler on the Roof*. Since the they have performed 18 more musicals, most of them very well known and loved such as *Showboat*, *My Fair Lady*, *South Pacific*, *Oklahoma* and *Anything Goes!* They have also staged some of the less well known but equally engaging musicals such as *Carrie* in 1995 written by Wesley Burrows of Glenroe Fame. *Carrie* is set in Dublin around a window cleaner, a maid and an American actress. In 1998 they staged *The Hired Man*, the story of Melvyn Bragg's peternal grandparents set around the mines and lands of Cumbria. This was a show much loved by the cast and audience alike, and it won the society an AIMS nomination for their choral singing. In 1999 they staged the Irish première of *Meet Me in St Louis*, the Judy Garland favourite.

2001 was probably the societies most successful show. With their production of *Guys & Dolls* came two AIMS nominations. Tahlia Marvin for her portrayal of Sarah Browne and Marijke Walsh for her portrayal of Adelaide, the long suffering fiancée for which she won Best Comedienne.

Kilmacud have had 21 years of music, fun, friendship and entertainment. We hope they will continue for the next 21 and we want to thank you, the audience, for all your support and encouragement. Thanks for everything and enjoy *The Magic of the Musicals*.
