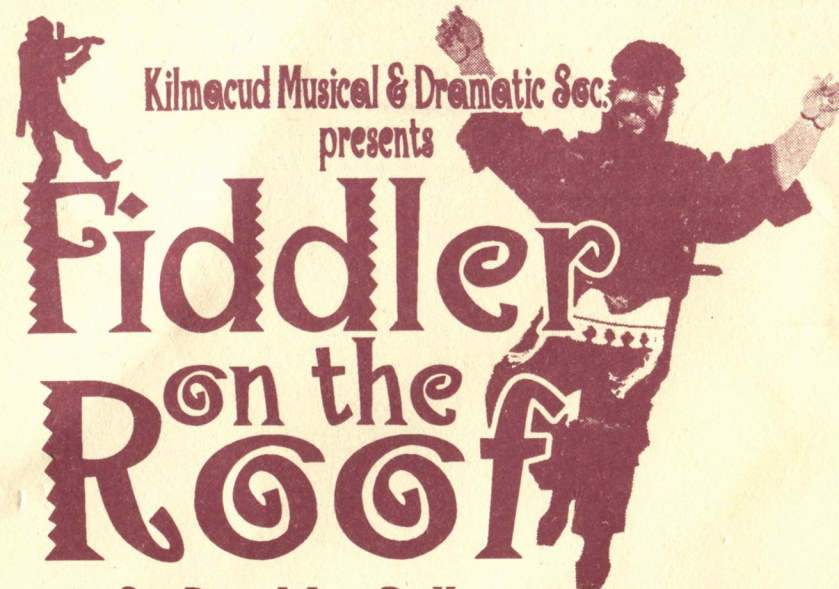

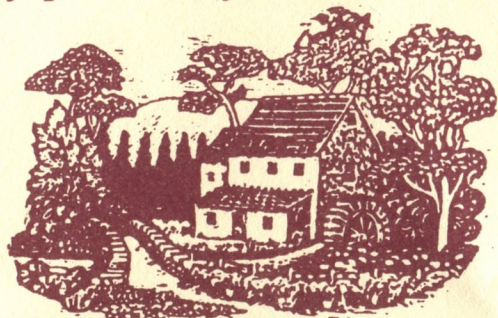

**ZERO MOSTEL** was the first of six actors to play Tevye on Broadway. The show ran for 3,242 performances from September 1964

The show opened in London in February 1967 with Alfie Bass as Tevye and ran for 2,030 performances.

The film version Paul Michael Glaser played the student Perchik. he later found fame as TV cop "Starsky".

Ruth Madoc who was cast in the film as the ghostly Fruma Sarah, is probably better known as Gladys, the welsh dragon, in the comedy series "Hi-Di-Hi".

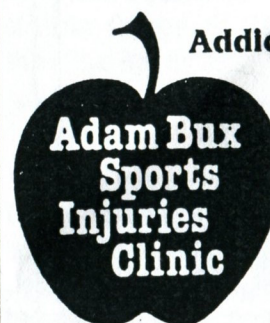

## Background to the Story

For a thirty year period from 1881 Jews living in the Russian Empire were subjected to a merciless series of pogroms. This religious intolerance culminated in the slaughter of some 300 Jews in Odessa in 1905, thousands of others being injured. Although considered outcasts, they were still required to carry out military service and there were 40,000 Jews in the Czarist armies.

Faced with eviction and butchery, they sought refuge in Western Europe but particularly across the Atlantic. In the period from 1880 to 1925, the Jewish population of the United States grew from 280,000 to over four and a half million. Many of these set out seeking the American Dream with nothing but a bundle of clothes, turning their backs for ever on the 'Anatevka' that had been home.

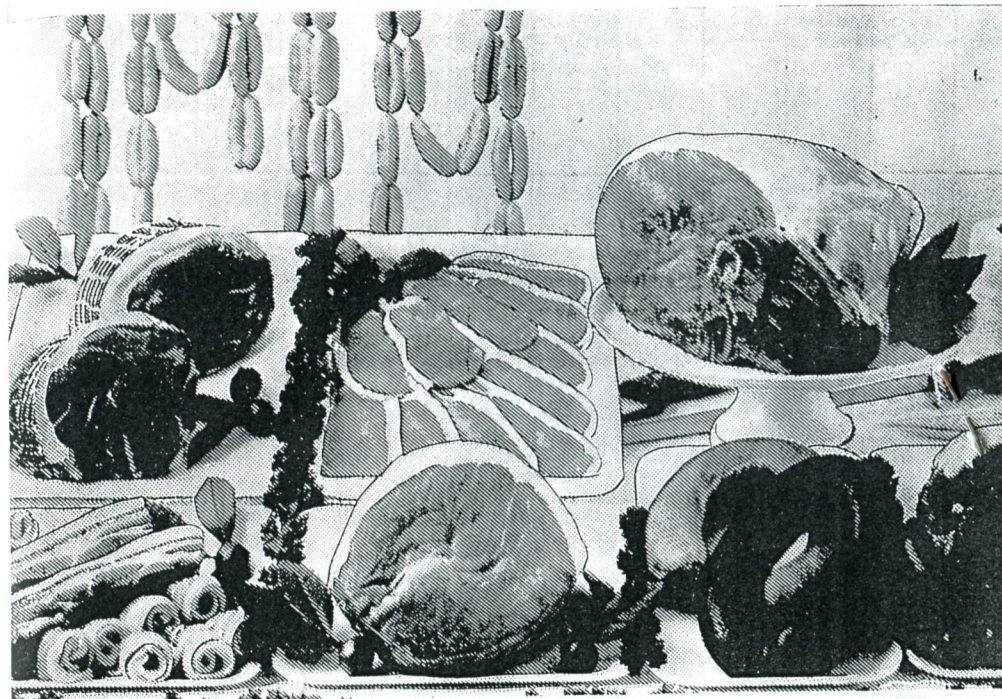

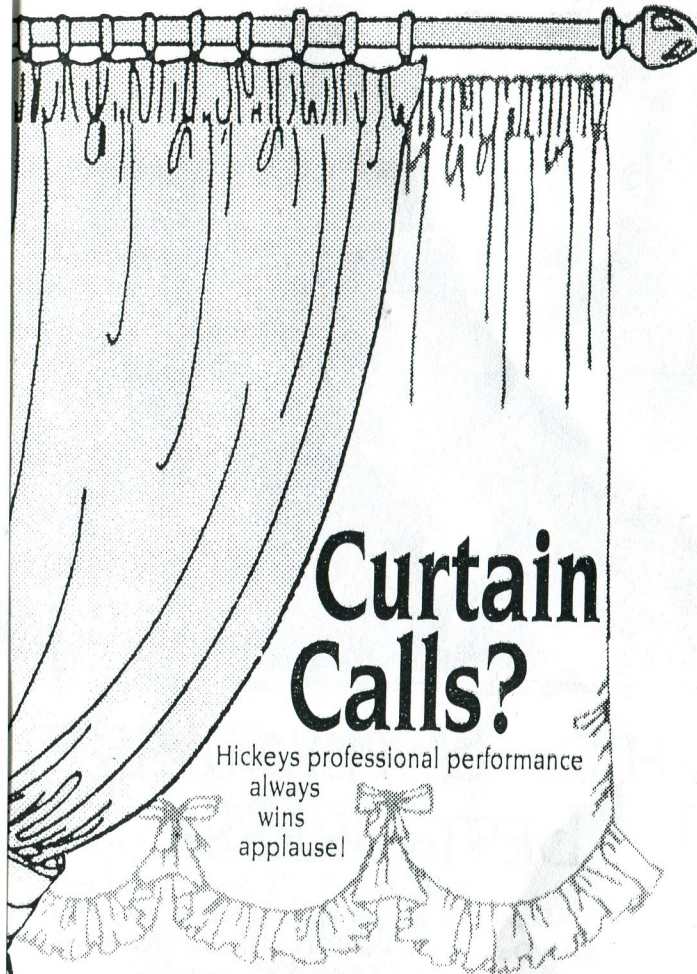

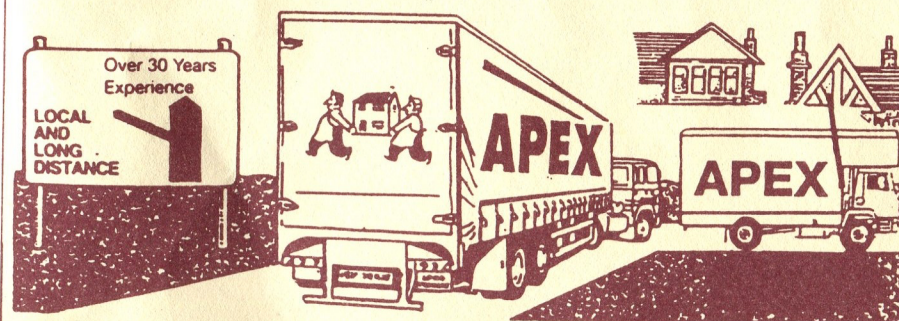
