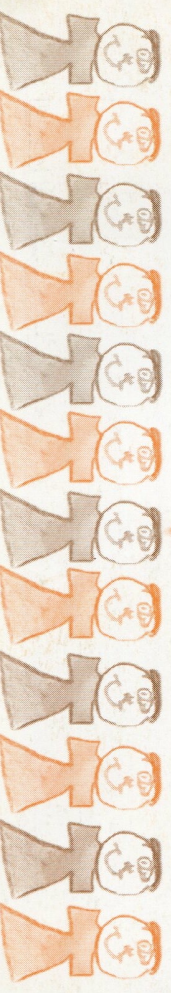

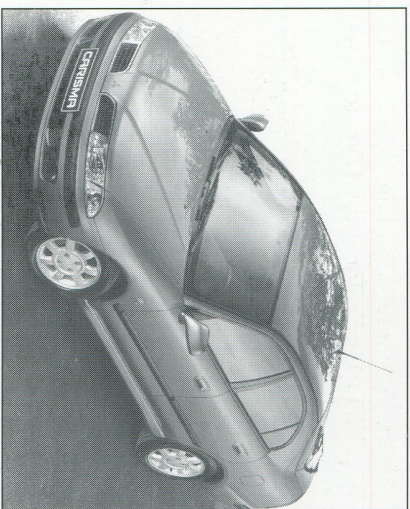

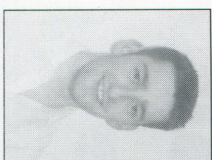

Joseph – PAUL BYROM



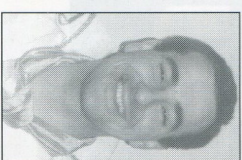

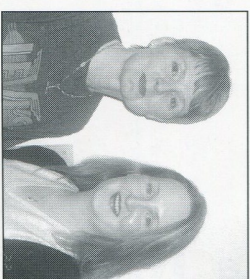
Mrs Potiphar – ROSALEEN DALTON

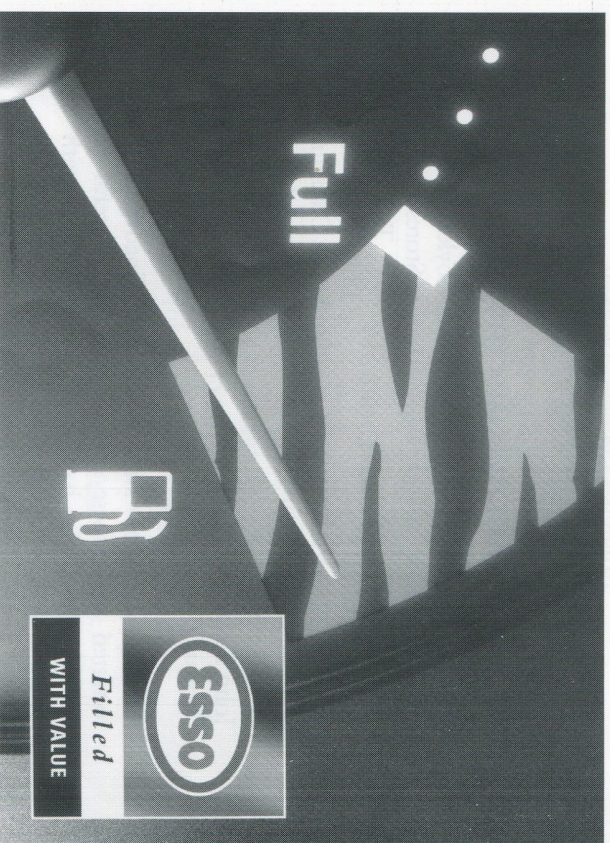

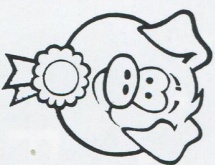

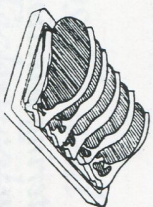
