



Synopsis

It all began in 1982, when the then Kilmacud Musical & Dramatical Society put on the classic John B. Keane play, Big Maggie. In 1988, it was decided to focus all our efforts on musicals and since then have staged many of the best known and loved musicals, including My Fair Lady, South Pacific, Oklahoma, Anything Goes and Fiddler on the Roof. In 2000, we even visited Canaan and Egypt for the first time in our production of Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, 25 years later, our members are delighted to be making a return visit! KMS celebrated its thirtieth anniversary by staging a

special variety show, it was such a success that we have

staged a variety show every year

since then! That same year we moved from St.Benildus College in Kilmacud, to The Mill Theatre in Dundrum where we have performed since. Our season now consists of the variety show in November, followed by our Spring musical. We are proud to be celebrating 43 musical years this year - here's to many more!




