About the show

When Nickelodeon cartoon *SpongeBob SquarePants* first hit TV screens in 1999, it was an immediate hit. Created by marine science educator Stephen Hillenburg, it introduced the world to a colourful cast of madcap sea creatures, led by the eternal optimist SpongeBob. The TV show attracted fans of all ages, including several of the artists who went on to write songs for the musical, such as *The Flaming Lips*, *Panic! At The Disco* and *Cyndi Lauper*.

Praised for its unique visual style, toe-tapping tunes and a socially-aware plot, *The SpongeBob Musical* took the musical world by storm when it opened on Broadway in 2017. The show was adored by audiences and critics alike and went on to earn an impressive 12 Tony nominations that year. It continues to be performed regularly all across the globe.

Bringing the world of Bikini Bottom to the Mill Theatre stage has been a mammoth undertaking for KMS. Countless hours of planning, rehearsal, and choreography have gone into the show, as well as the creation of more than 200 sound effects, 100+ screen visuals, 100+ props, and several dozen colourful costumes. And, of course, not forgetting the mindblowing talents of our crazy cast!

In the undersea town of Bikini Bottom, SpongeBob SquarePants wants nothing more than to be the manager of his beloved Krusty Krab restaurant. It all began in 1982, when the then Kilmacud Musical & Dramatic Society put on the classic John B. Keane play, *Big Maggie*. In 1988, it was decided to focus all our efforts on musicals and since then have staged many of the best known and loved musicals, including *My Fair Lady*, *Oklahoma*, *Anything Goes* and *Fiddler on the Roof* as well as modern hits like *Sister Act*, *Chess* and *9 to 5*. (You can see our full list of past productions on the opposite page.)

When KMS celebrated its thirtieth anniversary by staging a special variety show, it was such a success that we have staged a variety show every year since then! That same year we moved from St. Benildus College in Kilmacud, to the Mill Theatre in Dundrum where we have performed since.

Community has always played a major role in everything that we do. While our twice-weekly rehearsals are the main time we meet up, we also get together to see shows, at social gatherings and at our annual Christmas Carols. Since 2016, we've awarded the Spirit of KMS on the closing night of each show. The award celebrates an individual who selflessly assumes the ethos of KMS by proactively helping others, by working hard so that they can be relied upon, on stage and off, and by living the KMS values of friendship and respect.

Now in our 44th year, our season consists of the variety show in November, followed by our Spring musical. We hope you all enjoy your visit to Bikini Bottom as much as we've enjoyed diving in!
